Please join us to learn more about this potential opportunity for both you and your loved one.

The AFC program is a program funded by MassHealth that provides a tax-exempt stipend to family* or non-family members to care for people age 16 and older in a home setting, who cannot live safely on their own.

(*Spouses and guardians may not become the AFC Member's caregiver.)

Benefits of joining the AFC Program:

- RN's and Case Managers offer ongoing education, advocacy, and healthcare oversight;
- Non-taxable monetary support according to the needs of the individual cared for;
- 24-hour emergency line;
- Assistance with accessing community supports;
- Bi-lingual (Spanish/English) Case Management is available.

To qualify for AFC services, the member:

- Must have MassHealth (Standard or CommonHealth)
- Be 16 years or older; and have someone over the age of 18 acting as caregiver (cannot be spouse or guardian);
- Have one or more medical diagnoses;
- Require at least supervision throughout or physical assistance with one Activity of Daily Living (ADL), including: bathing, dressing, eating, transferring, or ambulating; and
- Cannot be left alone in the home setting for more than three hours per day.
